pilgrimage procession takes place to bring the statue of Lord Muruga on a golden chariot worth RM3 million led by more than 60 kavadis from Little India to the Arulmigu Balathandayuthapani hilltop temple off Waterfall Road. On Thaipusam day, devotees go through a physical endurance of being skewered and pierced on the back and front of their bodies as an act of penance.

Celebrations usually start on the eve of Chinese New Year where family members gather for a Reunion Dinner to enjoy traditional Chinese delicacies. The public is invited to be part of the celebrations by attending the Chief Minister's Chinese New Year Open House at SPICE Arena on 16th February (1st day of CNY) from 10.00am to 12.30pm.

The "Fire Watching" ceremony is a traditional ceremony to predict the economic outlook of Penang. This special prayer is also conducted to commemorate the birthday of Cheng Chooi Chor Soo Kong Deity of the temple which falls on 21 February. The ceremony is an annual event that attracts dedicated devotees not only from Penang but also other states in Malaysia and foreign countries to this famous Snake Temple which was formerly known as Ban Ka Lan in Hokkien. Besides the Fire Watching ceremony, devotees and visitors will also be entertained by various cultural dances, food stalls, exhibitions and exciting performances.

Ti Kong Seh in Hokkien (Jade Emperor God's birthday), is celebrated on a grand scale by the Hokkien clan to commemorate

their forefathers' escape in ancient China. This day is also the first day of the Hokkien New Year. At the stroke of midnight, prayers are performed with much gaiety with offerings of food, fruits, liquor and sugarcane stalks to the Jade Emperor God.





The pinnacle of the celebration is in the evening where there is a procession of floats decked with colourful flowers and bright lights accompanied by children singing and monks chanting prayers while sprinkling holy water throughout the journey.



On the 17th day of the holy Ramadhan month, a national-level celebration called the Nuzul Al-Quran is held to commemorate the day Prophet Muhammad S.A.W first received the revelation from Heaven. It is observed as a public holiday in most states in Malaysia.

In Malaysia, the Muslims celebrate the start of the month of Syawal by having open houses for their families and friends. Guests can enjoy a variety of

Another popular practice is the giving of "duit raya", money gifted to children, elders or to the poor in little green packets.

Over 150 contingents representing various government agencies such as the State Secretariat, PDRM, BOMBA and Angkatan Tentera Malaysia will be taking part in the parade. The Penang State Government will also be holding a celebration to commemorate the establishment of the Malaysian Federation, also known as "Malaysia Day". It is a significant date in the history of Malaysia as it marks the joining together of Malaya, Sabah and Sarawak to form Malaysia in 1963.



Awal Muharram or also known as Maal Hijrah marks the first day in the Islamic Calendar (Hijrah Calendar). It is equivalent to the 1st of January in the Gregorian Calendar. It is a public holiday in most states of Malaysia. Awal Muharram also marks a very significant event in Islamic history- Prophet Muhammad's (PBUH) emigration from Mecca to Medina. The event is known as "Hijrah" which directly translates to "Migration".



Mid-Autumn Lantern Festival

The Lantern Festival or Mid-Autumn Festival is celebrated widely by the Chinese community in Penang and is a time when family and friends gather together to admire the full moon while savouring Moon Cakes, Chinese Tea and parading around with colourful Chinese lanterns. Penangites and visitors can enjoy the festival at various locations such as Butterworth, Bukit Mertajam, Nibong Tebal and Kepala Batas.



The Nine Emperor Gods' Festival (Kew Ong Yeah) is celebrated on the 1st till the 9th day of the ninth month in the lunar calendar. Throughout this festival, many rituals such as skewering and fire walking ceremonies are carried out. Devotees also practise vegetarian diet for these nine days. On the last day, the Gods are sent off through a procession leading to the sea on an "Emperor Boat".
