In addition, sports events such as the annual Penang Bridge International Marathon is popular around the globe among marathoners and sports enthusiasts.

However, with the recent Covid-19 pandemic, many have decided to opt for a virtual/ hybrid platform to showcase these festivals and celebrations. Meanwhile, all physical events will adhere to the Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) set by the government.




