

1 CITY HALL

Completed in 1903, the City Hall was occupied by the Municipal Council the following year. It was renovated for the first time in 1960 since its construction. External viewing.

2 TOWN HALL

Built for social functions such as weddings and parties, it was declared open in 1880. Its rooms were used as municipal offices until 1903. The building was also once used as a private college until its reinstatement as a venue for civic events after its restoration in 2005. External viewing.

3 PENANG STATE ART GALLERY

Officially launched in 1964, the Penang State Art Gallery houses a comprehensive collection devoted to modern and contemporary art. The non-circulating collection documents paintings, sculptures, drawings, prints, photography, architecture, design, performances, videos, films, and emerging art forms from year 1965 to the present.

4 ESPLANADE (PADANG KOTA LAMA)

Penang Recreation and Cricket Clubs occupied the field till 1932. In 1908, the Cricket Club built a 2-storey pavilion to replace their old one and it was given up in 1940 to be demolished for the Esplanade to be returned for public use.

5 FORT CORNWALLIS

The original nibong palm stockade fort, built in 1786, was replaced by a brick structure complete with a moat in 1804-1805. The moat was filled up in 1922.

ZONE IDENTIFICATION

Core Zone - 109.38ha
 The Historic City of George Town covers an area of 109.38 hectares bounded by the Straits of Melaka on the north-eastern cape of Penang Island, Lorong Love (Love Lane) to the north-west and Gai Lebuh Melayu, Lorong Carnarvon and Lebuh Carnarvon to the south-west corner. There are more than 1,700 historic buildings within this Core Zone aligned on four main streets of Pengkalang Weld, Lebuh Pantai, Jalan Masjid Kapitan Keling and Lorong Love, as well as several perpendicular streets of Jalan Tun Syed Sheh Barakbah, Lebuh Light, Lebuh Gereja, Lebuh China, Lebuh Pasar, Lebuh Chulia, Lebuh Armenian and Lebuh Acheh.

Buffer Zone - 150.04ha
 The Core Zone is protected by 150.04 hectares of Buffer Zone (not including sea buffer), bounded by a stretch of sea area around the harbour, Jalan Lim Cheew Lee and Jalan Gat Prangin to the south-west corner and Jalan Transfer to the north-west corner.

THE HISTORIC CITY OF GEORGE TOWN

On 7th July 2008, George Town was awarded UNESCO World Heritage status. Founded 200 years ago, the city has an impressive collection of historic buildings representing the cultural heritage of Penang's various ethnicities: Chinese, Indians, Arabs, Malays, Acehnese, Siamese, Burmese and Europeans.

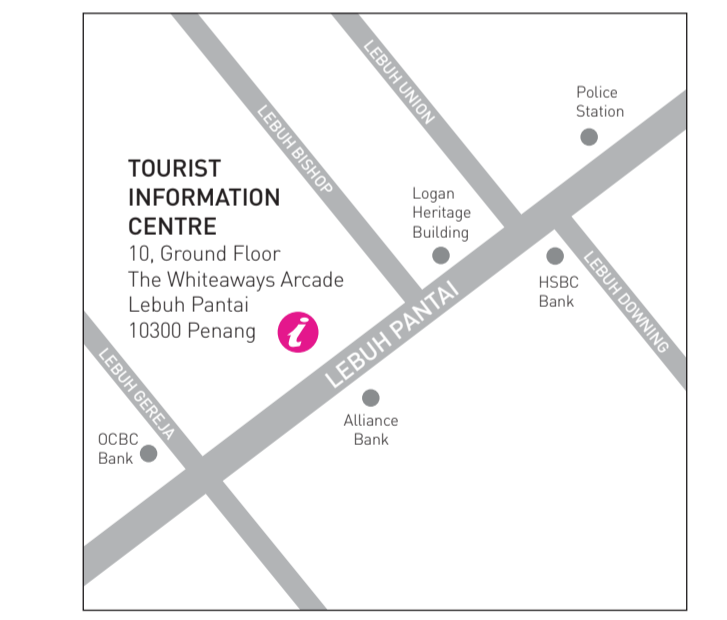

The Meromictic Lake comprising freshwater and saltwater is located in the Penang National Park. This phenomenon is a rarity where only three in Asia and one in Malaysia exist. Meromictic describes a condition where two layers of liquids (salty sea water and fresh water) of different density and temperature combine but remain separated. The Meromictic Lake only occurs between May to August in the year.

A second link was however completed in 2014 (Sultan Abdul Halim Mu'adzam Shah) with a total length of 24km, connecting the south-eastern part of the island to the mainland.
